# 1. New Features

## 3. Issues Resolved

### 3.1 Activation errors with redirected user profiles

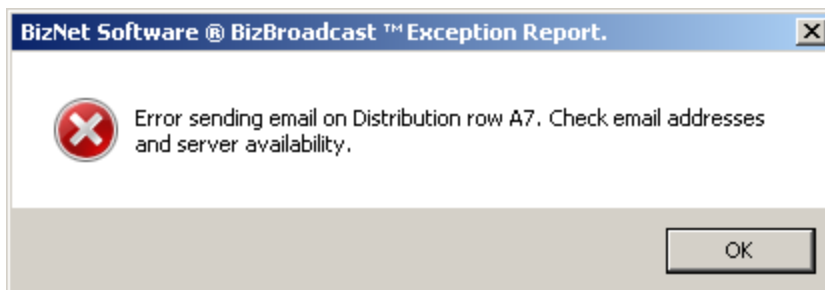
The activation files are now located in the same directory as the BizBroadcast installation files. This change addresses errors that were occurring when the folder was set to a network path or mapped drive on the network.

### 3.2 Excel 2013 crash using XLSXVALUES RenderFormat

When a distribution workbook used the XLSXVALUES RenderFormat and referenced many tabbed parameters, users may have experienced Excel 2013 crashing during distribution. The incidents were only reported in Excel 2013. This issue has been resolved in this new version.

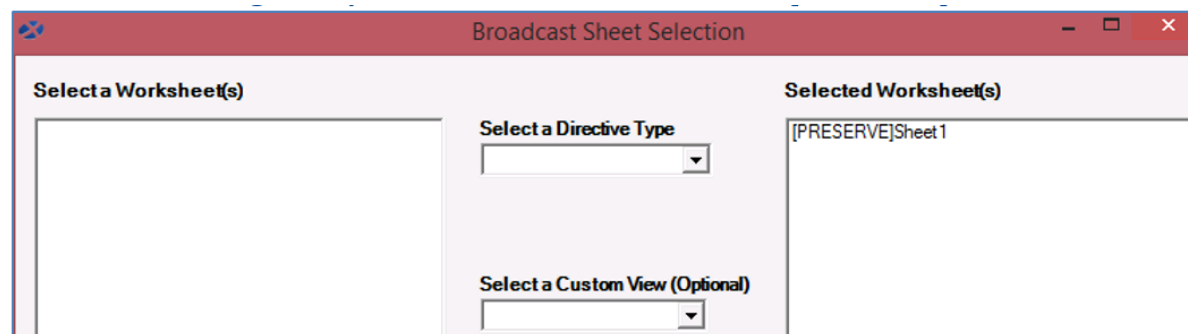
### 3.3 DoNotProcess Directive Support

Previously, users received the following error when they used the DoNotProcess key phrase as part of the formula to do conditional broadcasts. The product has been updated to eliminate this message. The user will no longer receive this error when using formulas with conditional formatting.



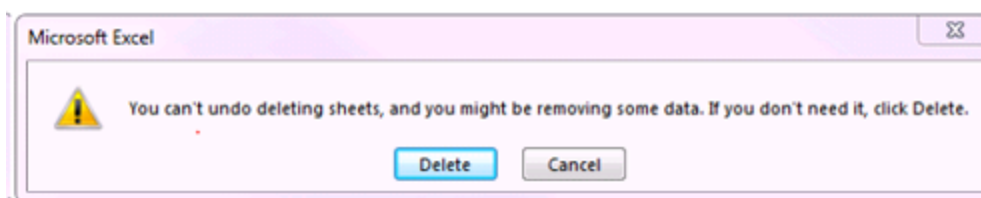
### 3.4 Removed Warning Prompt on XLSM RenderFormat with [PRESERVE]

When using an XLSM RenderFormat, selecting the [Preserve] directive caused a warning message to occur and users were prevented from using the [PRESERVE] directive. The product has been updated to allow the use of the [PRESERVE] directive with XLSM render formats.



### 3.5 Render Format XLSXVALUES with Pivot Tables

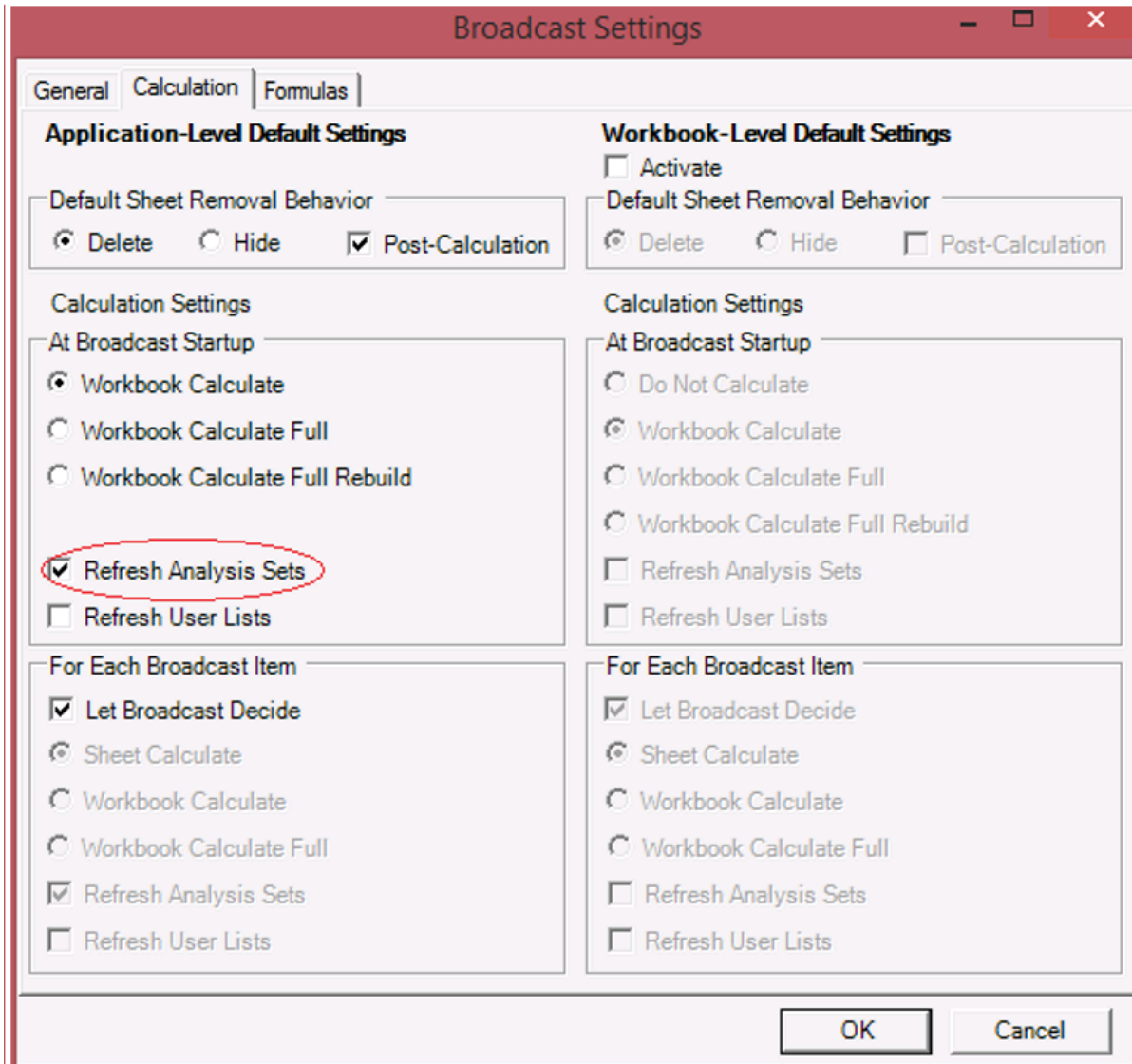
When a user created a pivot table in combination with a render format of XLSVALUES, a message displayed (Delete Sheets) and the user would have to click Delete or Cancel to proceed. This issue is resolved in this release.



### 3.6 Refreshing Analysis Sets during Distribution

When a user distributed a BizBroadcast report containing Analysis Sets, the Analysis Sets did not refresh.

This issue is resolved and BizBroadcast will refresh Analysis Sets during distribution when the Refresh Analysis Sets option is enabled in Application Settings.

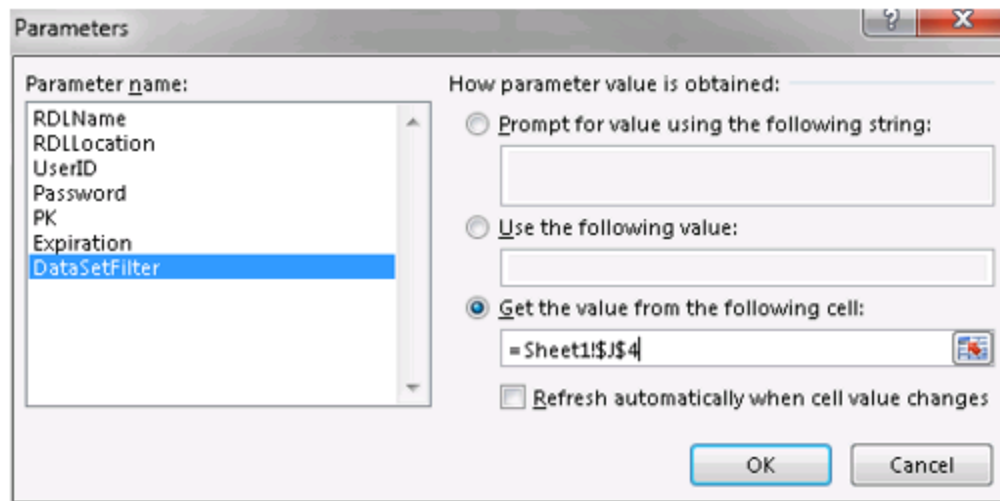


## 4. Known Issues

1. When errors are prompted during BizBroadcast processing, reference the About box for further details on the issue.
2. A Reference Error can occur in any workbooks. If cell referencing is used in the Distribution Template and the reference is broken or missing, BizBroadcast processing may return a #REF! error in the Excel. ID: -2146826265 in the file or file-name.

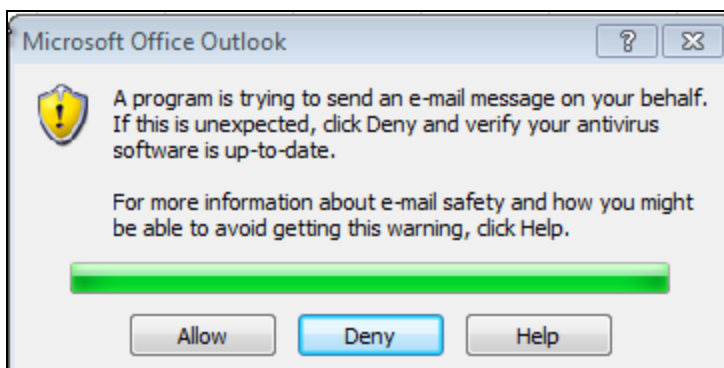
**Workaround:** If the drag and drop method is used, save the Distribution template in only xlsx format for Broadcast to process. The newly created workbook will need to be saved on the local machine for Broadcast to distribute multiple times. While in Excel, open the workbook template separately and click the Run Now button to process the Broadcast distribution template.

3. When users save a BizBroadcast Distribution Template with a workbook containing dynamic analysis sets (see screen shot below) and the user attempts to run a distribution, BizBroadcast will prompt the user to save the workbook and fail to distribute after the first time. Excel workbooks that are dragged and dropped from BizInsight are created as a temporary file on the local machine. BizBroadcast is unable to recognize a temporary file. The workaround for the drag and drop feature in BizInsight is to save the BizBroadcast Distribution Templates in xlsx format and save the newly created workbook on the local machine for BizBroadcast to distribute multiple times.





4. BizNet Software, Inc does not recommend using BizBroadcast to distribute workbooks with worksheet event macros (ie. Worksheet\_Activate, Worksheet\_SelectionChange, etc). During distribution, the macro will run once during the refresh phase of the broadcast, then again as BizBroadcast processes the worksheets(s) being distributed. In total, the macro will be executed at least twice during a BizBroadcast distribution resulting in degraded distribution performance.
5. If BizBroadcast is used to distribute reports via email using Outlook and an anti-virus program is not installed on the workstation, Outlook security will prompt the user to Allow or Deny the email for each distribution row. Install an anti-virus program on the workstation to address this issue.



6. Excel 2007 contains unsupported icons for **Check for Updates** and **Buy Now** ribbon Buttons.
