1.1. Major Feature


1.1.1. Expression Editor



The Expression Editor is a task pane input box in Excel that enables a user to write logical expressions based on fixed values, logical operations, and functions. The basic editor environment is recognized for ease of use expression building that auto complete expressions and error checks. The advanced editor environment provides the more experienced report builder all of the basic editor benefits with additional control over the operators and function types. The application requires BizInsight build 5.0.34.2 or later and supports Office 2003, 2007, 2010, and 2013.




1.1.2. Access to SQL Server


Access to SQL is an internal conversion application for BizNet administrators to migrate BizNet biz files (BizInsight.biz and BizInsight.DB) into SQL Server databases. The application requires BizInsight build 5.0.34.2 or later and SQL Server 2005, 2008, 2008 R2, or 2012. The application resolves issue swith saving PivotLayouts, Account Definitions (BizProperty), and the Optimize Cache 255 character length limitation.





1.1.3. Account Definition Functions

Account Definition is a built-in set of functions, located within BizInsightXL.Foundation, which provides an organization the ability to store a list of values and retrieve the stored value from BizInsight. The new functions are a robust and improved version of the BizProperty functions (SetBizProperty and GetBizProperty).




2.1. Major Enhancements

2.1.1. Windows 8, Office 2013 32bit/64bit, and SQL Server 2012 Support

2.1.2. Additional Support for Other Data Providers



Supports Oracle 10.5 and 11

Development attempted to use a generic OLEDB provider and syntax to replace a lot of parameter binding code with one set; however, additional components are needed for an Oracle connection. If the Oracle .NET Provider is utilized the connection works, but requires tighter constraint on the installation requirements.

In addition to the Oracle Client installation, the ODP.NET will also need to be installed.


There are two installation methods:


- 1. Oracle Universal installer requires the correct bitness driver for Office installation, either 64-bit or 32-bit version. Download a separate installation of the Oracle Universal Installer.
- 2. Oracle Xcopy package (only the loose files) is faster, but harder to implement and great for system admins. ODP.NET installation is required.


Users are provided an error prompt if the Reporting Services path contains syntax issues.






Successful BizNet Refresh



Unsuccessful BizNet Refresh




2.2.3. Errors and Events Captured in Event Logs




2.2.4. Query Timeout Setting for Support Troubleshooting


Query time-outs are typically a connection CommandTimeout. The CommandTimeout setting is now configurable in BizInsight under XMLFAST options. The default CommandTimeout for XMLFAST is 200 seconds. The default ConnectionTimeout for XMLFAST is 15 seconds.



2.2.5. BizInsight Warning Prompt on Excel Close to Save Changes to the Navigation Pane






2.2.8. BizInsight Offline Mode is a Toggle Button


3.1.1. Trial Date and Trial Mode Displays Correctly




3.1.2. Multi-Monitor Dialog Support

BizInsight is able to detect whether Excel is on the main display or on an extended display. All prompts are displayed on the active Excel monitor. Exceptions to the active display monitor are caching and Scan for Content prompts. Users are able to disable caching prompts in the Application Settings.

Caching prompts




Scan for Content prompt

3.1.4. Resolved Exceptions When Refreshing Query Tables

Objects in the workbook silently fail when exception is thrown. Check the error log from the About button to review exceptions.

3.1.5. Scan for Content Improvements

ScanForContent detects Excel.exe for other users on terminal services environments.

The check to wait is removed and will commence running regardless of the state of Excel.exe.

3.1.6. SSRS 2008 R2 Requires XMLFAST to be Enabled in BizInsight.

Removed support for ATOM Feed on SSRS 2008 R2. Users will receive the error prompt, "This version of SQL Server does not support XML Export, please use XMLFAST under Application Settings" and will be given the option to cancel.



3.1.7. Pivot Layout Sort Order Fix


The order of the row fields are saved in the exact order which the user saved the pivot layout.





3.1.8. Power User Role Displays as "Viewer" in the About Button

Power is a legacy user role type and contains the same features as Viewer.



3.1.9. BizInsight Drill-down Fix

Right-clicking on certain parts of an Excel sheet may cause an exception "Error generating drilldown menus".

The addressed exception scenarios:

• Right-click on a function with no parameters

- · Right-click on an empty cell
- Right-click on a cell that contains an Excel formula
- Right-click on a cell that contains numeric or string data
- Right-click on Analysis Set Pivot (PivotTable)
- Right-click on an Analysis Set List (QueryTable)
- Right-click when selecting more than one cell (a range of cells)
- Other scenarios may still exist

4. BizInsight - Known Issues

1. When using F2 to check a function, most errors will return #VALUE! Go to **About** > **Support Tools** > **View Events** to see the error.



- 2. Analysis Set Refresh is not addressed.
- 3. In AccesstoSQL Configure settings, IP addresses are saved in the connection string, but do not appear when re-launching the Configure SQL dialog to review the current settings.
- 4. Scan for Content throws an exception on Office 64-bit versions when moving from one set of Content Packs to another.

For example, if a user is currently using MAS500GL and wishes to switch to another configuration folder containing a different set of Content Packs, ex: MAS500AP and MAS500AR, ScanForContent throws an exception that it is not able to find the MAS500GL 64-bit files in the content path. The workaround is to manually register the new 64-bit Content.

5. BizInsightXLFoundation add-in unregisters during initial BizInsight startup steps.

In some environments, it has been observed that the BizInsightXLFoundation add-in will become unregistered when starting up Excel after an initial installation and using Scan for Content. The steps to avoid this issue involve starting Excel twice after installation before scanning for content. The installation documentation has been updated to reflect this installation best practice.

6. Scan for Content Errors when Applicaton Settings paths are Mapped Drives

ScanForContent does not support mapped drives. A mapped drive cannot be used in the AdminPath or ConfigPath. The issue is not reproduced when using a full network drive name (\\servername\sharename) or a local drive (c:\).
