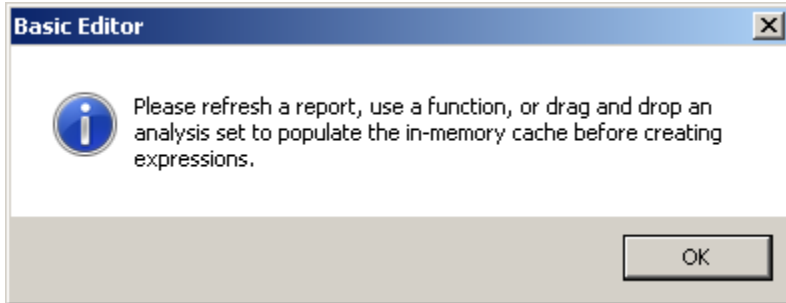

1. BizInsight – Enhancements

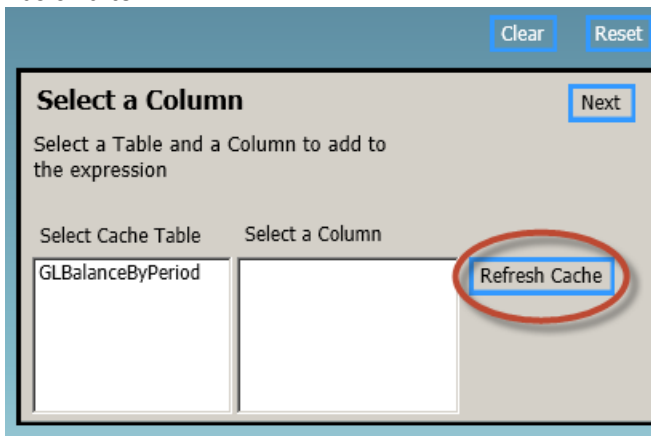
1.1. Expression Editor Enhancements

1. A new dialog has been added to Basic Editor to notify users where there are no data caches in memory. A data cache must exist in memory in order for the Expression Editor to work.

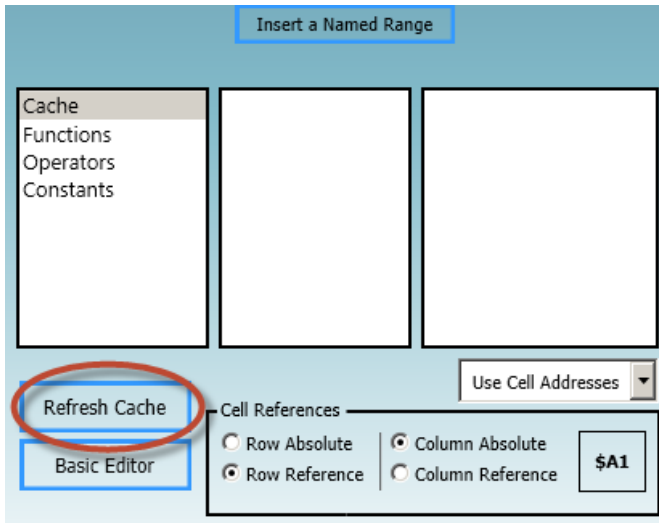


2. A Refresh Cache button has been added to both the Basic and Advanced Editors. When using the Expression Editor over long periods of time, you may need to refresh the available cache columns for use in building expressions. Press the button to make available cache columns from the data that is added to cache during the Excel session.

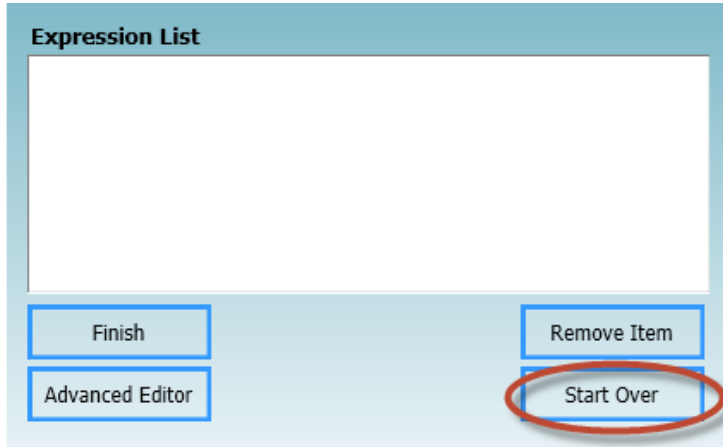
Basic Editor



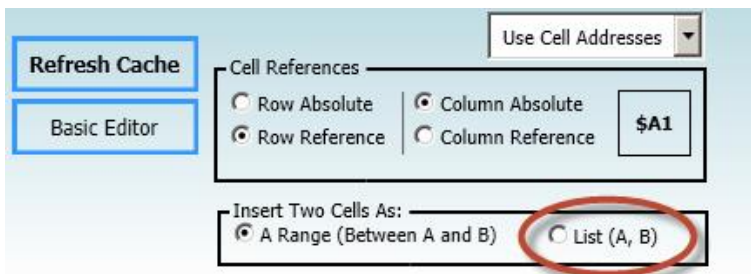
Advanced Editor:

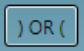


3. A Start Over button has been added to clear the current expression as well as the entire expression list. Additionally, clicking this button also refreshes the cache tables.



4. In the Advanced Editor, the “Values (A,B) “ radio button changed to “List (A,B)”

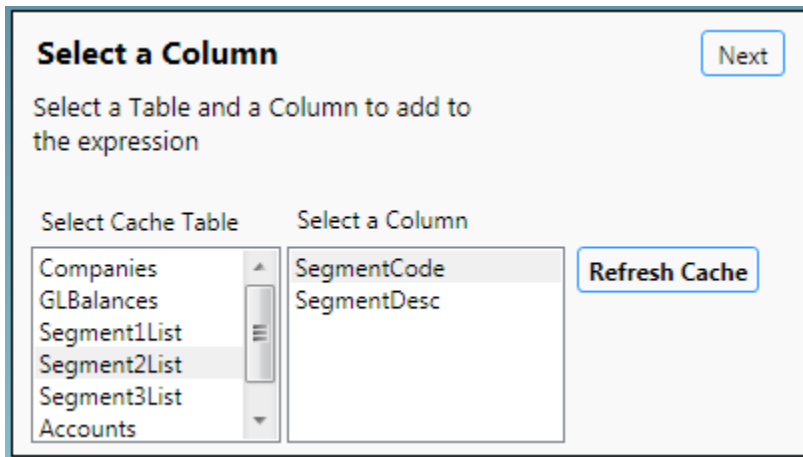


5. In the Advanced Editor, the buttons have been re-ordered to optimize user experience. In addition, a new  button was added.



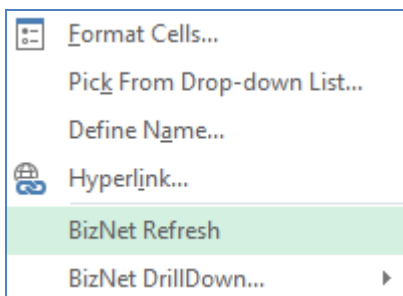
2. BizInsight – Bug Fixes

1. When using the Basic Editor and selecting cache columns, pressing the down arrow too quickly in the scroll could cause the selection of the cache column before the user had indicated what column to select. This bug has been fixed.

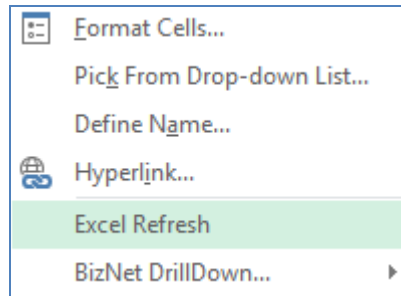


2. The bug preventing Power/Viewer users from dragging and dropping Analysis Sets into a worksheet has been resolved
3. The right-click menu has been fixed in Offline Mode to display “Excel Refresh” instead of “BizNet Refresh”

4. The registration issue with the BizInsighr.XLFoundation in Excel 2013 64-bit has been resolved

5. Issues with re-registering BizInsight Office 2013 32-bit have been resolved. Previously, when users re-registered BizInsight, the registration did not work properly. Now users of Office 2013 32-bit are able to unregister and re-register successfully.

3. Known Issues

1. In Excel 2003, Expression Editor is disabled. Users must upgrade to Excel 2007 or higher or manually create their expressions.
2. Excel 2013 Advanced Expression Editor and Cache dialog issue. The current workaround is to have the setup files begin with the Cache Dialog and Use Advanced Editor option
